Step 1: In the Box

Verify all components are included:

- HC200 Smart Camera
- USB-C Power Adapter
- HDMI Cable
- Remote Control


Use only the parts provided. Each is optimized for safety, compatibility, and performance.



Step 2: Camera Tour


Privacy Shutter Indicator Light

Closes when idleFlashing Blue = SetupSolid Blue = Connected




Rear Flap for TV or shelf placement.

Step 3: Mount Camera



Use the front lip and rear flap to balance the camera securely on top of your television. The rear flap also acts as a base for safe shelf placement.

Step 4: Connection Map



Use this diagram to see how everything connects before getting started. You'll complete these steps one by one in the next pages.

Step 5: Video Reciever



Connect your set-top box to the camera's HDMI IN port, not directly to the TV. This lets HomeSight add overlays during video calls and remote care sessions.

Step 6: Connect HDMI





Plug the HDMI cable into the "TO TV" port. Then, connect the other end to your television's HDMI input.

Use an open port like HDMI 1 or HDMI 2. Remember the port—you'll need it later.

Step 7: Connect Power



Order matters to ensures video signal is detected for HDMI handshake:

- 1. Power the camera first via USB-C.
- 2. Wait for blue light to stop blinking.
- 3. Then power on the set-top box.
- 4. Begin on-screen setup only after.

Step 8: Pair the Remote



Switch your TV to the correct HDMI input. The welcome screen will appear shortly. Follow the on-screen pairing prompt to connect the included remote control.

Step 9: Pairing Buttons




A red light above the mic button will flash when pairing is complete. This confirms the remote is now connected to your Smart Camera.

Step 10: Connect Wi-Fi



After choosing your language and scanning for available networks, connect the SmartSight camera using your preferred method. You can also return to this screen in Settings to delete old networks.


Step 11: Wi-Fi Success



The camera tell if you the Wi-Fi connections has been successful.

The camera will now check for software updates, which can take up to 15 minutes—keep the TV on until it's finished.

Step 12: TV Control



This step enables TV Control so you can toggle between live TV and the HomeSight screen using the HomeSight remote. This allows you to watch and receive alerts with minimal disruption.

Step 13: Default TV Input



Choose the HDMI input you use for live TV. This tells the camera where to take you when you exit the HomeSight screen.
Use the arrows, then press OK to save.

Step 14: Scene Preview



The camera's shutter opens and shows a live view on your TV. A green frame marks what others will see during video calls. Adjust the camera as needed to frame your background settings.

Step 15: Assign a Room

Scroll through the list using your remote. Select the room where this camera is set up. This helps label and organize your devices. Press OK to confirm and continue setup.
